Volunteer Sign-Ups and Orientation for the three west-slope Sierra Gold Sector State Parks (South Yuba River SP, Empire Mine SHP, and Malakoff Diggins SHP) will be held at Empire Mine State Historic Park Docent Room on Saturday, March 4th from 9:00 am-3:30 pm **and** Saturday, March 11 from 9:00 am-3:30 pm. For your convenience, attendance at only **one** Saturday session is required.

Each session will cover what a “Volunteer Means to California State Parks” and will discuss park policies, procedures and philosophy. We will, as a group, be guided through the hiring paperwork and discuss the benefits of being a State Park volunteer. Since a criminal background check is required prior to working as a State Park volunteer, there will be onsite finger printing “live scan” being conducted during the Saturday sessions. Individuals will need to bring to the sign-up a photo ID and \$10 check or cash for the background processing.

If you are interested in becoming a volunteer at Malakoff Diggins SHP, please join us on one of the two dates, March 4 or March 11, to begin a fulfilling experience as a volunteer for our beautiful state parks.
